### Personal data

Place of birth Rio de Janeiro, Brazil in 1934

### Medical education

- 1960 Medical Degree from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro
- 1963 Masters degree in Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation was completed at Oxford University (England)
- 1966 Doctorate in Orthopaedics and Traumatology from the Federal University of Minas Gerais (Brazil)

### Professional activities

- 1960 PDr. Campos da Paz joined, as a junior member, the first medical team at Brasília's District Hospital
- 1964 Returning from England, he was appointed chief of the Orthopaedics and Traumatology Department of the Brasília District Hospital
- 1968 He became director of what was then called the Sarah Kubitschek Rehabilitation Center
- 1975 He wrote the "Plan for developing a regional orthopaedic and rehabilitation program", which gave origin to the SARAH Network of Hospitals for the Locomotor System
- 1981 The President of Brazil appointed Dr. Campos da Paz President of the Pioneiras Sociais Foundation, which included various units, among them the SARAH Network of Hospitals for the Locomotor System. As President, he instituted the regime of full-time, exclusive dedication not only for the staff physicians, but for all of the professionals who worked at the Institution. He also created the Center for Hospital Technology (EquipHos), for the development of orthopaedic and rehabilitation equipment.
- 1986 The Minister of Health and Social Welfare, appointed Dr. Campos da Paz Coordinator of the Integrated System of Rehabilitation in Traumatology and Orthopaedics (SIRTO), whose objective was to establish standardized technical procedures for use in Brazilian public hospitals. This work was approved by the National Health Council.
- 1991-1992 The President of Brazil appointed Dr. Campos da Paz to the National Health Council for outstanding professional achievement, during the period between November, 1991 and November, 1992.
- 1991 He administered the transformation of the Pioneiras Sociais Foundation into the Pioneiras Sociais Association, through a landmark law sanctioned by the Brazilian Congress in October 1991. Thus was born the SARAH Network of Rehabilitation Hospitals: the first public institution in Brazil that is Federally-funded, privately run and under the control of the Federal Audit Court.  
Aloysio Campos da Paz is currently President of the Pioneiras Sociais Association and Surgeon-in-chief of the SARAH Network of Rehabilitation Hospitals; Coordinator of the SARAH Network's Human Resources Program, which selects and trains all the staff employed at the Network's seven hospitals in Brasília, Belo Horizonte, Salvador, Fortaleza, Rio de Janeiro and São Luís, in addition to the Technology Center and University. He is also Dean of the SARAH University of Rehabilitation Sciences.
